



Mr. Flamur Mrasori was born on September 5, 1983 in Gjakova. In 2005, he has completed his studies at the Faculty of Law of the University of Prishtina. During his studies, he was given the "Distinguished Student" award by the University of Prishtina. In 2008, he completed Master studies at the same University. In the course of his academic advancement, in 2016, Mr. Mrasori has completed his doctoral studies in the field of International Law at the University of Prishtina. Currently he is Professor at the Faculty of Law in University of Prishtina, International Law Department with focus on "The European Union Right" and "Private International Right ". During his academic career, Mr. Mrasori has published various scientific works from the field of jurisprudence and European integrations, and has participated in a number of international conferences, trainings and various workshops closely related to the field of jurisprudence and integration in general and financial integration in particular.

Mr. Mrasori has worked in the Central Bank of the Republic of Kosovo for over 11 years, where he has exercised important functions. He has started his work in the CBK in 2007, in financial supervision and has later moved to the position of the Chief of Cabinet of the Governor. From 2013, Mr. Mrasori served as General Advisor to the Governor/Executive Board Secretary. During his service at the CBK, he was involved in all the important processes for accomplishment of the CBK objectives. As a Chairman of the CBK Commission for European Integration, Mr. Mrasori, participated the SAA dialogue process between Kosovo and the European Union. Mr. Mrasori was also a regular participant of the CBK delegation at the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank annual meetings, since the membership of Kosovo in these institutions.

On January 26, 2018 he was elected by the Assembly of the Republic of Kosovo and on February 5, 2018 was appointed by the President of the Republic of Kosovo as a non-executive member of the Central Bank Board of the Republic of Kosovo.

On March 22, 2018 by unanimous vote, Mrasori was elected Chairman of the CBK Board.

Mr. Mrasori is married and has two daughters.
