IMPLEMENTING UNMIK REGULATION NO. 1999/4 OF 2 SEPTEMBER 1999 ON THE CURRENCY PERMITTED TO BE USED IN KOSOVO

The Special Representative of the Secretary-General,

Pursuant to the authority given to him under section 5 of United Nations Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK) Regulation No. 1999/4 of 2 September 1999 on the Currency Permitted to be Used in Kosovo,

Hereby gives the following Administrative Direction:

Section 1

BUDGETS, FINANCIAL RECORDS AND ACCOUNTS

Pursuant to section 3 of UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/4 the budgets, financial records and accounts of public bodies, agencies or institutions and UNMIK shall be formulated in Deutsche Marks.

Section 2

COMPULSORY PAYMENTS AND ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

- 2.1 Pursuant to section 4.1 of UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/4, the designated currency to be used for compulsory payments shall be Deutsche Marks.
- 2.2 Pursuant to section 4.2 of UNMIK Regulation No. 1999/4, the administrative fee for a person wishing to make compulsory payments in Dinars shall be ten percent of the assessed compulsory payment.
- 2.3 Administrative fees and compulsory payments, if paid in Dinars, shall be calculated in accordance with the most recent reference exchange rate quoted by UNMIK.

Section 3

ENTRY INTO FORCE

This administrative direction shall enter into force on 4 October 1999.
